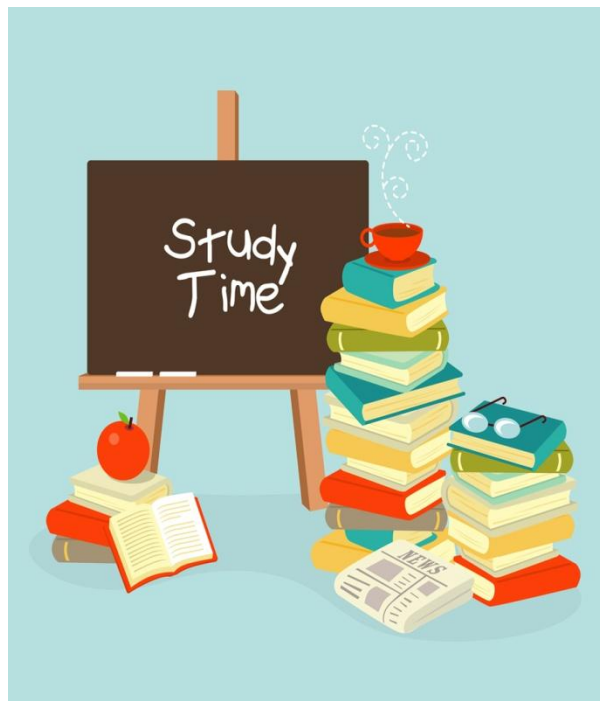


A Special Day Pre-K..Where Everyday is Special
